## **RESPIRATORY CARE: B.S.**

This program will be available in the Spring 2026 term.

The bachelor's degree completion program in respiratory care requires a total of 120 credits completed through a combination of respiratory care component requirements, transfer credits and credits earned by meeting SUNY Empire's general learning requirements. This is an upper-division online bachelor's degree completion program requiring an associate's degree in respiratory care from an accredited institution of higher education. Most students enroll on a part-time basis and complete the program in 36 - 48 months.

Students are required to have an associate degree in respiratory care from an accredited institution of higher education and hold a valid respiratory therapist license. This is a non-licensure qualifying program.

This 120-credit degree completion program will include 48 credits of upper-division program requirements and electives (listed below). Participating students may transfer up to 72 lower-division credits from an associate degree program (A.S., A.A.S.). Further, students completing an A.A.S. degree and missing any required general education and liberal arts credits, may take them post-associate degree and transfer them to SUNY Empire. These credits may also be taken with SUNY Empire, along with any remaining credits to reach the 120 required.
